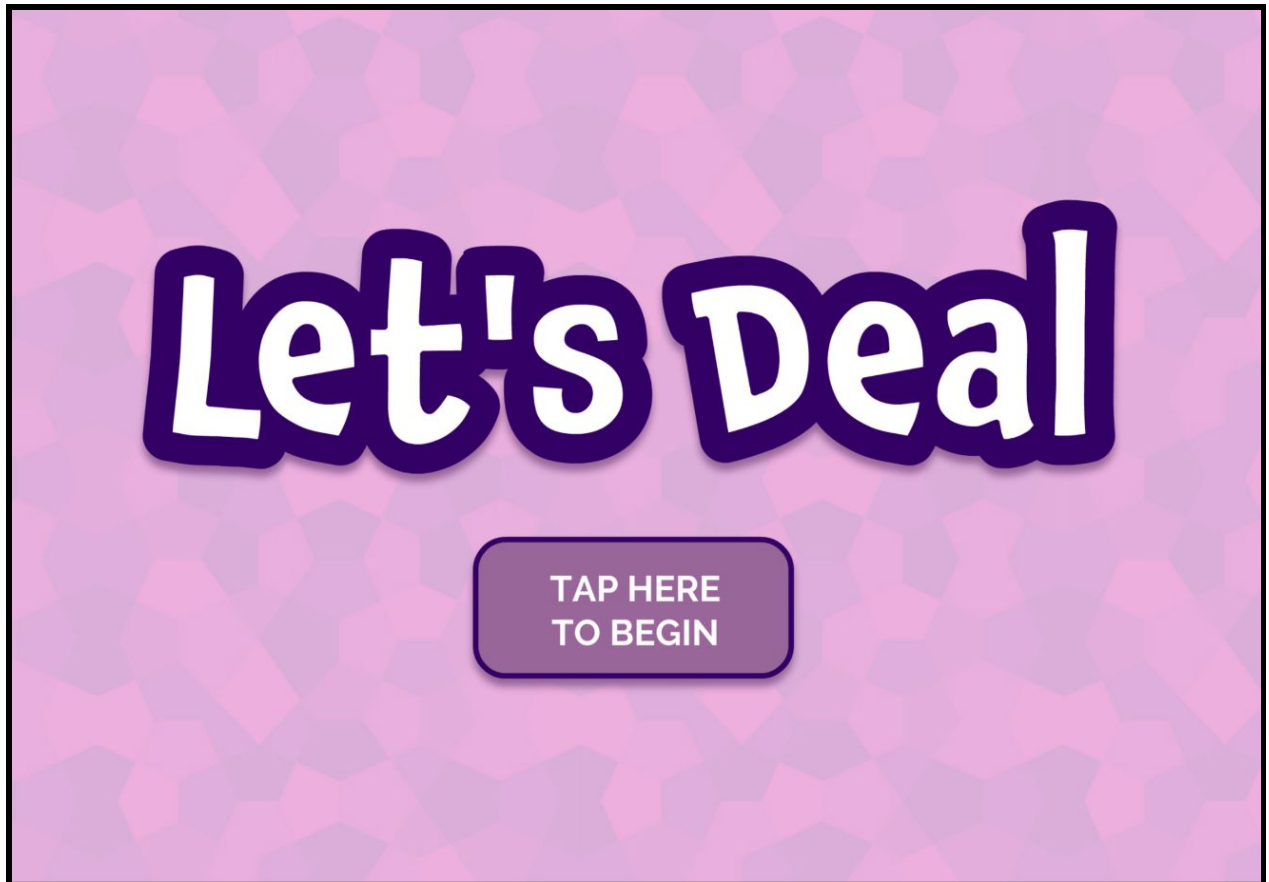

## << VIDEO 1 >>



**Jayden:** “Ah market day — time to make a deal! I’ve got firewood to trade. It’s useful for cooking and keeping warm. Everyone will want it!”

*(SFX: exaggerated stomach rumbling)*

**Jayden:** “But... it’s not great for breakfast. Can you help me trade the firewood for something I can eat--like eggs?”

**Narrator:** “Let’s help Jayden trade his firewood. Move Jayden’s firewood into his bin.”

## << VIDEO 2 >>

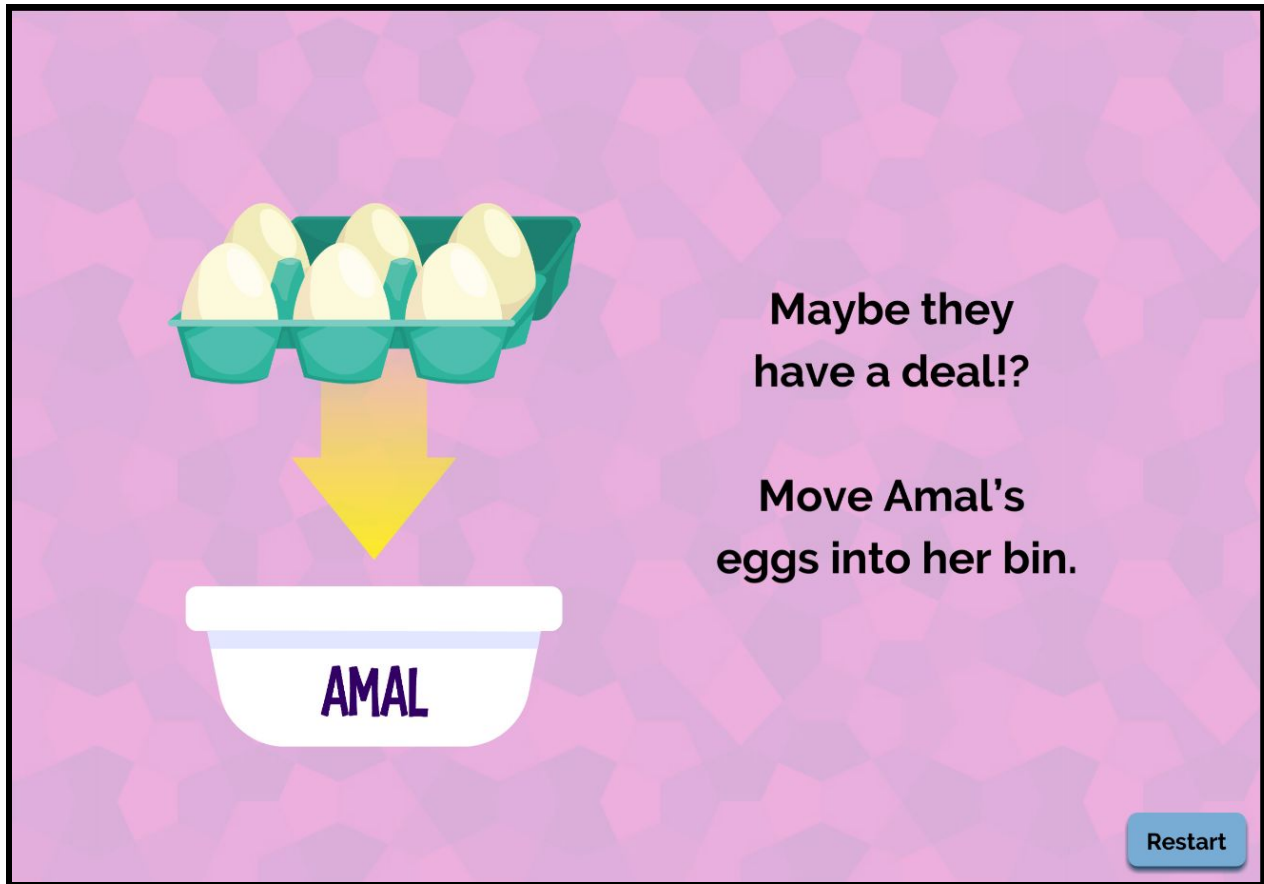


**Jayden:** “Great! Now we can trade the firewood for some eggs.”

**Amal:** “Hey Jayden, how’s it going?”

**Jayden:** “Egg-cellent! But I’d be even better if I had an omelet. Can I trade you some of my firewood for your eggs?”

**Narrator:** “Maybe they have a deal!? Move Amal’s eggs into her bin.”

**Narrator:** “Now make the trade! Swap the disks by putting Jayden’s firewood into Amal’s bin and Amal’s eggs into Jayden’s bin.”

**Amal:** “Hmmm (thinking), I can’t carry anything that big home today. And I can’t use firewood to pay bus fare.

Any chance you have something more *convenient*, something that would fit in my pocket?”

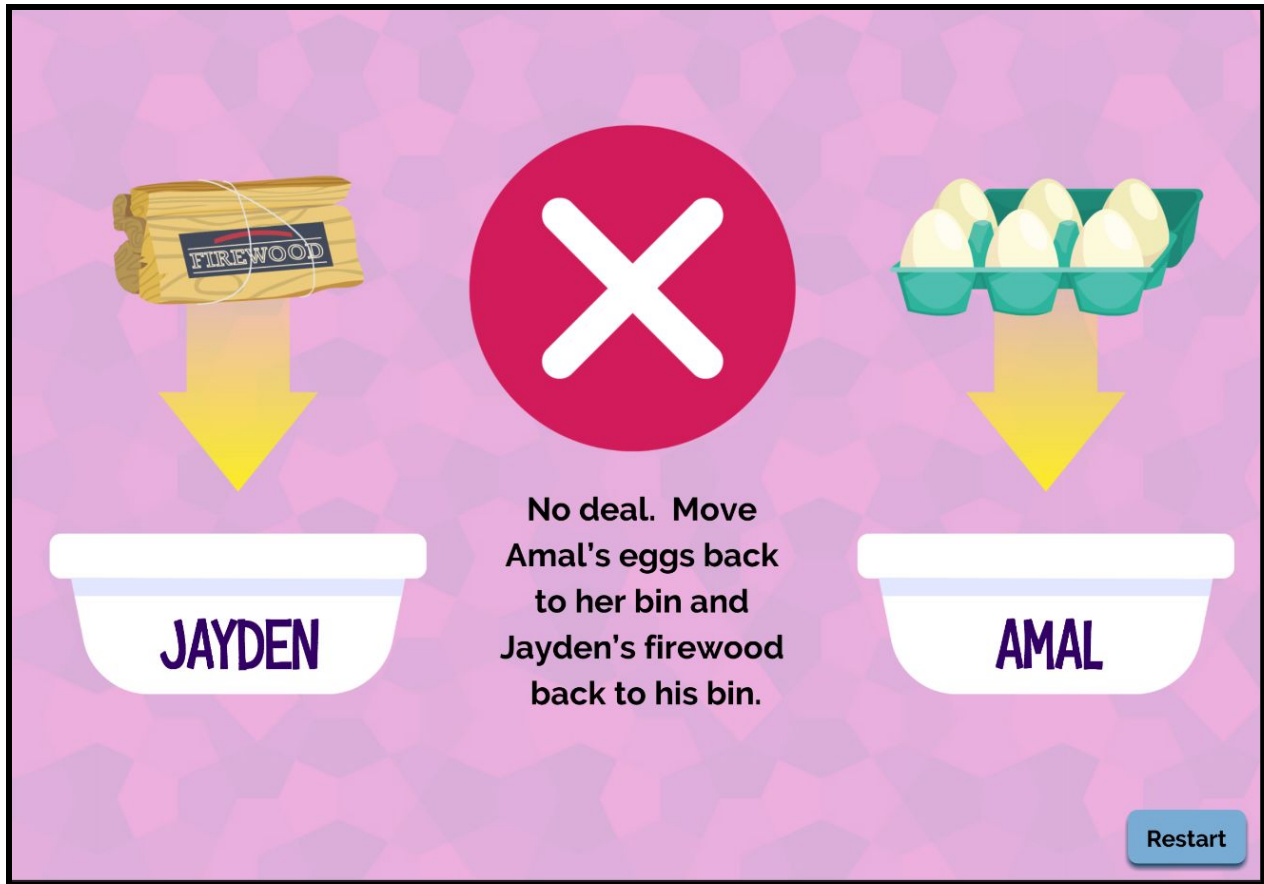


**Jayden:** “Pocket size pieces of wood? No, but think about how awesome a campfire would be tonight...and how hungry I am right now!”

**Amal:** “Sorry, Jayden. The deal doesn’t work for me. I can’t carry the wood.”

**Narrator:** “No deal. Move Amal’s eggs back to her bin and Jayden’s firewood back to his bin.”

## << VIDEO 4 >>



**Piper:** “Hi, Amal! May I have a dollar’s worth of eggs please?”

**Amal:** “Hi Piper! *(handing her the eggs)* Sure!”  
*(takes money and puts it in her shirt pocket.)*

**Piper:** “Thanks! Catch you later!” *(leaves)*

Jayden: “How could you??”

Amal: “Piper’s money is **convenient**--I can stick it in my pocket and carry it anywhere. Try doing that with eggs, OR firewood.”

Jayden: “Hmph.” (*grumbles*)

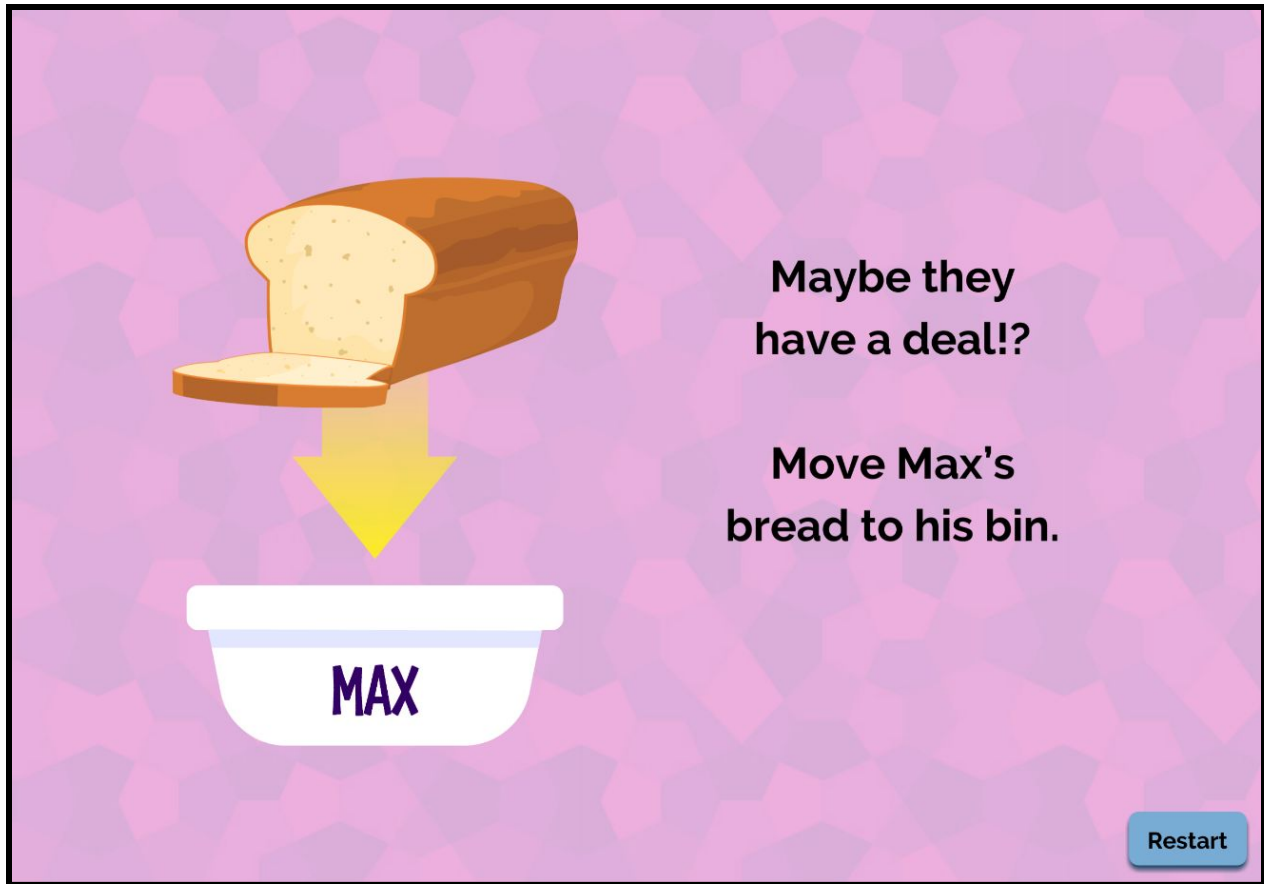

**Max:** “Hi Jayden.”

**Jayden:** “Hi Max! I’ve got this firewood that’s *perfect* for heating your baking ovens. Will you trade one of your loaves for some of my wood?”

**Narrator:** “Maybe they have a deal? Move Max’s bread to his bin.”

**Narrator:** “Now make the trade! Swap the disks by putting Jayden’s firewood into Max’s bin and Max’s bread into Jayden’s bin.”

## << VIDEO 5 >>

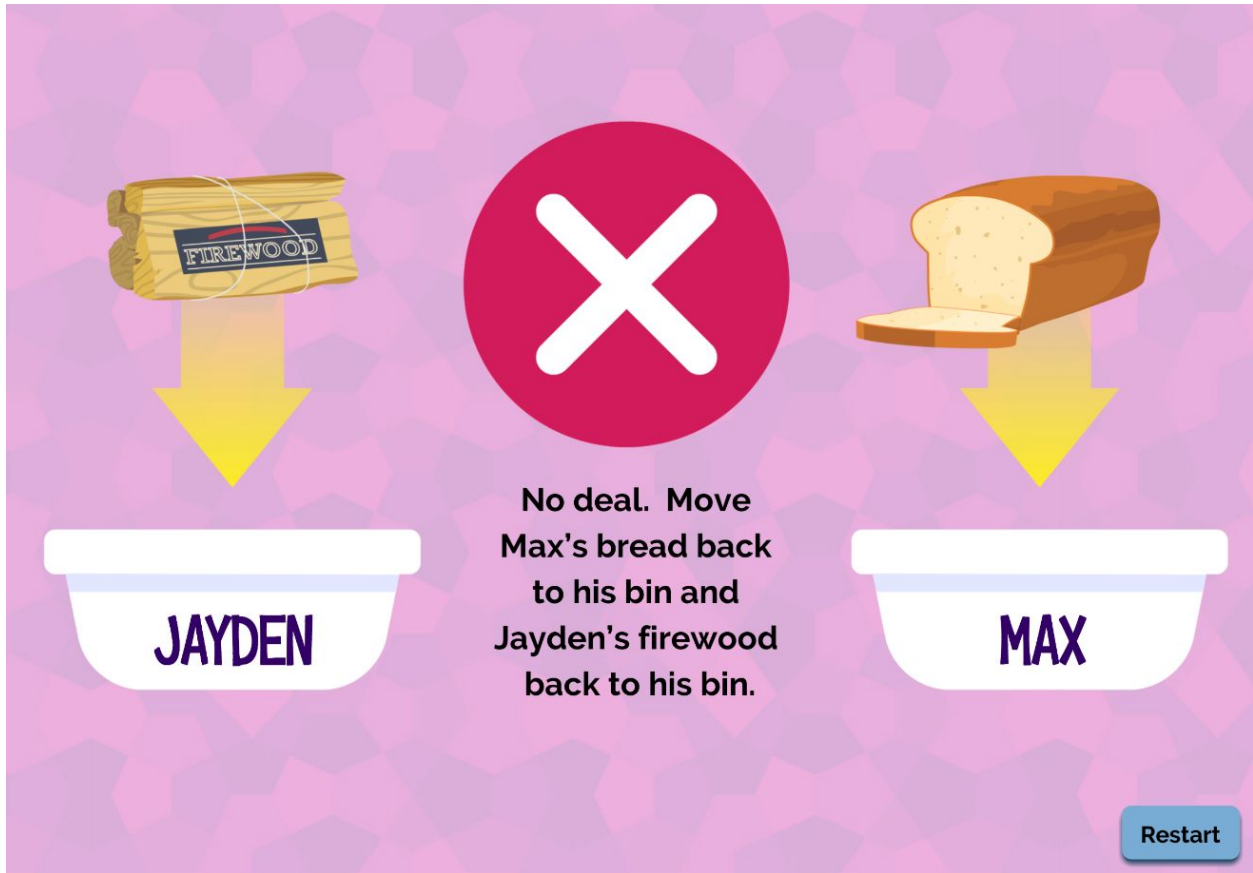


**Max:** “I do need wood. The way I see it, my loaf is worth three and a half of your logs.”

**Jayden:** “Ugh. I don’t have an axe, and there’s no easy way to **divide** these logs. (*SFX Stomach growling*) Shhh! Quiet in there.”

**Max:** “Sorry, Jayden. If you can’t divide the logs, we can’t make a fair trade.”

**Narrator:** “No deal. Move Max’s bread back to his bin and Jayden’s firewood back to his bin.”

**Piper:** “Hiya Max! Can I have a loaf of bread? I have a five dollar bill.”

**Jayden:** (*sarcastic*) “Oh good, it’s you.”

**Max:** “Sure! That’ll be three dollars and fifty cents... so you get a dollar fifty back in change.”

**Piper:** “Perfect! See ya!” (*leaves*)

Jayden: “Really, Max?”

Max: “Unlike your firewood, Piper’s money is easily **divisible**. I was able to break it into smaller amounts and give her change, so we are both happy.”

Jayden: “I’m thrilled that you and Piper are happy.”

Sofia: “Hi Jayden!”

Jayden: *(hyper)* “Sofia! So good to see you!  
I’m a huge banana fan. I’m bananas for  
bananas!”

Sofia: “Great! How many would you like?”

**Jayden:** (*nervous, looking around*) “Well, umm, how many can I get for this bundle of firewood? (*mumbles*) I know she’s around here somewhere...”

**Narrator:** “Maybe they have a deal? Move Sofia’s bananas to her bin.”

<< USER INPUT REQUIRED >>



**Narrator:** “Now make the trade! Swap the disks by putting Jayden’s firewood into Sofia’s bin and Sofia’s bananas into Jayden’s bin.”

**Sofia:** “Thing is, I can’t use that much firewood very quickly. It will get soggy and bugs will eat it before I can use it all.”

**Narrator:** “No deal. Move Sofia’s bananas back to her bin and Jayden’s firewood back to his bin.”

Jayden: “Not you again!!!”

Piper: “Hey Sofia! The last thing on my shopping list is bananas. Do you have any?”

## << VIDEO 8 CONTINUED >>



**Sofia:** “You’re in luck. This is my last bunch. That’ll be a dollar twenty-five, please. I’ve reduced the price because I know they won’t last another day, unlike your cash, which *won’t* spoil. Money is **durable** — I can use it today or a year from today.”

**Jayden:** “That’s it! What does Piper’s money have that my firewood doesn’t?”

**Piper:** “Really, Jayden? Let’s review:  
Money is **convenient**--it’s easy to carry  
around.

Money is **divisible**--it can easily be broken into  
smaller parts, and still have value.

Money is **durable**--it lasts a long time.

And, as you can clearly see, **money is  
accepted pretty much everywhere.**”
